Janet has a very unusual job. She works in a big nature park in Africa as a wild animal tracker. She knows what the footprints of different wild animals look like so that she can track or follow them and learn how to keep them safe.

Janet's job can be difficult. Sometimes it's very hot and she has to walk for a long time to find the animals that she is tracking. She often follows the footprints of big animals like elephants. Elephants

can walk hundreds of kilometres and they can be frightening when they are angry. Because of this, Janet doesn't usually work alone. She works with a team of trackers, who can help each other if an animal becomes dangerous.

Janet loves her job because she is very interested in wild animals and what they do every day. Her favourite animals are giraffes and lions. She thinks it's very important to look after the environment.
